ASSOCIATION OR ANY OTHER PARTICIPANT IN THE

GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE BY REASON OF SUCH

PARTICIPATION.

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#### MISCELLANEOUS

## L. GROUP GRIEVANCE

IF AN ALLEGED GRIEVANCE IS ONE WHICH CANNOT BE RESOLVED AT THE PRINCIPAL'S LEVEL, THE GRIEVANCE MAY BE ENTERED AND PROCESSED DIRECTLY AT LEVEL 2 OF THE GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE.

## 2. SEPARATE GRIEVANCE FILE

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#### ARTICLE IV

# A. SALARY SCHEDULE

## EXCEPTIONS

WHEN A PAYDAY FALLS ON OR DURING A SCHOOL HOLIDAY, REGULAR SCHOOL CLOSINGS OR WEEKEND, ADMINISTRATORS SHALL RECIEVE THEIR PAY CHECKS ON THE LAST PREVIOUS WORKING DAY.

#### ARTICLE V

A. THE BOARD OF EDUCATION AGREES TO PROVIDE BLUE CROSS, BLUE SHIELD, MAJOR MEDICAL AND RIDER J COVERAGE, OR COVERAGE SIMILAR TO THE STATE HEALTH BENEFITS PLAN FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THIS UNIT.
