### RECOMMENDATION

The recommendation to approve the Memorandum of Agreement is based upon the following pertinent data:

### Duration:

Four (4) years

### Wages:

- A. Effective and retroactive to January 1, 2014 2.00% increase in base
- B. Effective and retroactive to January 1, 2015 2.00% increase in base

- D. Effective January 1, 2016 2.00% increase in base pay;
- E. Effective January 1, 2017 2.00% increase in base pay.

### 3. Health Benefits

Employees may select any health plan offered by the County. Employees hired after the full execution of this agreement shall not be eligible for Traditional coverage.

### 4. Health Benefits

Revise to provide:

"Employees shall contribute amounts as set forth by Chapter 78, P.L. 2011. Once full implementation is reached, the contributions shall remain at the maximum level of contribution set forth in Chapter 78, P.L. 2011 for the remainder of this Collective Negotiations Agreement, through December 31, 2017."

### 5. Meal and Break Periods

Modify the last sentence of the last paragraph of Article 20 as follows, "...unless authorized by the Director or his designee."

### 6. Retention of Existing Benefits

Revise the first sentence of Article 4 to say as follows:

"The rights, privileges and benefits which these employees have heretofore and are enjoying via this Agreement shall be maintained and continued by the County during the term of this Agreement until the ratification/approval of a successor agreement notwithstanding any statute, law, ordinance, precedent or ruling by a Court or State agency."

### 7. Reciprocal Days

Delete last sentence of Article 11.

### 8. Retroactive Pay

Add provision:

"Employees who sever employment with the County prior to the execution of this Agreement will not be included in this wage increase, with the exception of retirees in good standing."

### 9. Extent of County Liability

Amend Article 13 to provide for counsel rate of \$80.00 per hour.

### REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

This Memorandum of Agreement provides for a fair economic settlement for the employees and the County.

### FISCAL IMPACT

The Office of the County Treasurer estimates the fiscal impact to be 1,366,296.00.

### **ALTERNATIVE**

The alternative is to reject the Memorandum of Agreement and to proceed to Interest Arbitration.

# MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX AND THE ESSEX COUNTY SUPERIOR OFFICERS ASSOCIATION, FOP LODGE 106

The County of Essex, (the "County") and the Essex County Superior Officers

Association, FOP Lodge 106 (the "Association"), having engaged in collective negotiations,
hereby mutually agree as follows with respect to modification of the terms of Memorandum of
Agreement which expired on December 31, 2013.

1. The terms of the 2011-2013 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties shall remain in full force and effect except as herein modified.

### 2. Term of Agreement

A term of the new Agreement shall be for a period of four (4) years, effective January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2017.

### 3. Wages

Wages shall be increased as follows:

TICC - 1' 1 TO 1 - 2014	2.0007
Effective and Retroactive to January 1, 2014	2.00%
Effective and Retroactive to January 1, 2015	2.00%
Effective January 1, 2016	2.00%
Effective January 1, 2017	2.00%

Step movement shall continue per Article 6.

### 4. Health Benefits

Employees may select any health plan offered by the County. Employees hired after the full execution of this agreement shall not be eligible for Traditional coverage.

### 5. Health Benefits

Revise to provide:

"Employees shall contribute amounts as set forth by Chapter 78, P.L. 2011. Once full implementation is reached, the contributions shall remain at the maximum level of contribution set forth in Chapter 78, P.L. 2011 for the remainder of this Collective Negotiations Agreement, through December 31, 2017."

### 6. Meal and Break Periods

Modify the last sentence of the last paragraph of Article 20 as follows, "...unless authorized by the Director or his designee."

### 7. Retention of Existing Benefits

Revise the first sentence of Article 4 to say as follows:

"The rights, privileges and benefits which these employees have heretofore and are enjoying via this Agreement shall be maintained and continued by the County during the term of this Agreement until the ratification/approval of a successor agreement notwithstanding any statute, law, ordinance, precedent or ruling by a Court or State agency."

### 8. Reciprocal Days

Delete last sentence of Article 11.

### 9. Retroactive Pay

Add provision:

"Employees who sever employment with the County prior to the execution of this Agreement will not be included in this wage increase, with the exception of retirees in good standing."

### 10. Extent of County Liability

Amend Article 13 to provide for counsel rate of \$80.00 per hour.

- 11. This Memorandum of Agreement, together with the 2011-2013 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties, represents the complete and final agreement between the parties, and is contingent upon ratification and approval of the association membership, the Essex County Executive and the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders.
- 12. All proposals, whether written or oral, presented by the parties during the course of the negotiations are deemed withdrawn and not a part of this Agreement. This Agreement cannot be modified except by a writing signed by the parties.
