I. General Terms and Conditions.

IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY agreed by and between the parties that the duration of the "Agreement between the Township of Mount Holly and the Employees of the Township of Mount Holly, Burlington County Council #16" dated April 1, 1979 is hereby extended and shall continue in effect until March 31, 1981 and Section VIII thereof Term of Agreement is amended accordingly.

II. Section XVI: Pay Plan, Subsection 1, of the said April 1, 1979 Agreement is hereby amended to provide for the following pay range for the established pay grades:




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III. All other provisions of said April 1, 1979 Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
